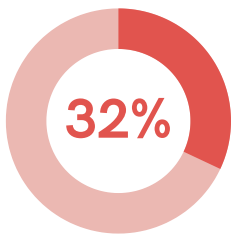

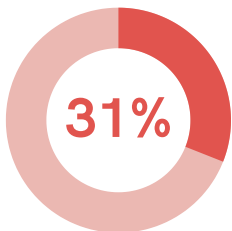

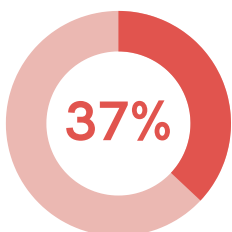

Financial Narrative



The year 2021 saw huge progress in financial & operations management.

Significant milestones included:

- Standardized the financial tracking system, with new monthly templates, receipt scanning and filing standard operating procedures. and gas/mileage logs for all vehicles to track their use in sanctuary operations
- Opened a sanctuary-only bank account at the CNB Bank, Inc. in Berkeley Springs, WV, the local branch of a regional bank. This ensures proper management and tracking of donated funds to better separate personal income with sanctuary income
- Opened a P.O. Box to receive regular mail (such as donation checks) and packages from donors directly and our various online "wishlists"
- Established new avenues for donations and fundraising
 - PayPal and Venmo options (Cash App coming in 2022!)
 - Fundraising via Facebook/Instagram
 - Amazon Smile account for indirect donations

We were also able to accomplish several targeted fundraising initiatives this past year.

- August - fundraised to rescue Ruby from a kill pen (\$950 bail + \$150 transport)
- October - fundraised for materials to build stalls in the barn for Ruby & Coco (\$635)
- November - fencing fundraiser to purchase materials to repair and build fencing for the goats (\$1500)
- December - the first ever auction to raise funds, with auction items donated by Fiberworks
